

HARBOUR REGULATIONS Delta Marina

1. It is forbidden to disturb others by playing music or unnecessarily operating generators or motors or otherwise making excessive noise in the marina and related grounds and buildings.
2. It is forbidden to make use of an unenclosed fire source on the harbour grounds.
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash when on the harbour grounds and must be let out outside the harbour grounds.
4. Boating with motorised rubber boats, dinghies, water scooters etc. in the harbour is forbidden.
5. To minimise fire hazard, it is forbidden to carry out repairs on motors and boats located in the harbour if temperatures can thereby occur at which petrol/oil can catch fire or explosion/fire can be caused by gas installations.
6. Anyone operating a boat in or near the harbour must comply with a maximum speed limit of 5 km/h.
7. Commercial activities of any kind are forbidden.
8. If they leave their mooring berth for one or more days, owners of boats are required to report this to the harbour master. The empty mooring berth may then be used for whatever purpose necessary without any moorage refund being necessary.
9. Without written permission from the owner, no boats, accessories, inventory or other possessions will be handed over to third parties.
10. Owners of boats are required to ensure that their boat is properly moored in such a fashion that it cannot cause damage to any other boat or property. Outboard motors must be fixed in a vertical position. Owners of boats must make sure that proper mooring ropes and fenders are used. Tarpaulins and other accessories must be left behind in such a fashion as to ensure that they are not a nuisance to anyone else. The landing stages must always remain free of obstacles. It is forbidden to attach fenders or similar material to the landing stages or mooring poles or to lay down floor mats on the walkway. However, Dock & Post Bumpers are permitted. If, in the opinion of management, the owner is remiss in these respects, then management may take the measures it thinks necessary at the cost of the negligent owner.
11. All persons parking vehicles must follow the instructions of management or the harbour master.
12. Cleaning a boat with the help of high-pressure water jetting is permitted only at the landing stage intended for that purpose.

13. Transient boat owners are those owners who do not have a fixed moorage place for their boat. If permitted to do so by the harbour master, they may choose to anchor their vessel in the marina.
14. A moorage place will not be granted to boats which could cause problems due to their exterior appearance and/or state of maintenance. This assessment is left to the discretion of management.
15. Management cannot be held liable for missing goods which belong to clients, visitors or guests.
16. If they sell their boat, owners must immediately inform management accordingly.
17. If people in a boat make a public nuisance of themselves, management has the right to forbid their entry to the marina.
18. In all other cases not covered or not explicitly covered by these regulations, the instructions and explanations of the management or harbour master must be complied with.

Environment

- It is explicitly forbidden to dispose of waste material, such as plastic packaging, in the harbour or to dispose of oil or water contaminated with oil in the harbour.
- Within the framework of the Tax on Pollution of Surface Waters Act, it is forbidden to carry out any maintenance activities on boats which could directly or indirectly pollute the water and/or the grounds. The following activities are forbidden:
waterproof sanding and spray cleaning
sanding/scraping without taking measures to remove fine suspended particles
treating the hull without placing foil beneath the boat
- It is strictly forbidden to use an (automatic) bilge pump.
- It is forbidden to enter the harbour grounds with Jerry cans of petrol or diesel fuel.
- It is forbidden to use an underwater toilet in the harbour.
- The **H.O.I. (harbour depot installation)** near the crane is intended for receiving waste materials containing chemicals and/or oil. Please follow the relevant instructions very strictly.
- Please get rid of your paper, cans and glass (sorted by colour) at the environmental recycling facility.
- In so far as relevant, all owners of boats and caravans are responsible for ensuring that gas installations are properly installed and safe to use.
- Tapwater is an expensive product and should therefore be used sparingly. Do

not allow children to play with water and hoses. It is forbidden to wash vehicles on the harbour grounds.

The harbour master is responsible for supervising compliance with the harbour regulations.

In addition to these harbour regulations, the Hiswa (Netherlands Association of Enterprises in Water Recreation) General Terms and Conditions for Renting and Letting out moorage berths (for vessels and similar goods) and the Hiswa General Terms and Conditions for Contracting, Selling and Delivering, as contained in the most recently registered text with the registry of the District Court of Amsterdam, apply.
